You are receiving this communication to notify you of your child's intent to participate in the 2019 Australian STEM Video Game Challenge.

Held annually, the Australian STEM Video Game Challenge is a free-to-enter, not-for-profit initiative facilitated by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER). Designed to help encourage participation with skills and concepts related to the disciplines of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) the competition asks participants to design and build an original video game, and in doing so, to engage with a self-directed, iterative development process that requires problem solving, collaboration and the acquisition of technical skills that are highly relevant to both future career paths and emerging industries within the global economy.

Open to Australian students in Years 5-12, and permitting students to work together in teams comprising up to four (4) members, the Australian STEM Video Game Challenge is a valuable cross-curricular exercise that encourages team-work and co-operation, and builds on several facets of the new Digital Technologies strand of the Australian Curriculum.

The Australian STEM Video Game Challenge will run from Tuesday 19 February – 7 October 2019 inclusive.
